This has reference to Circular No. AHCT/Emp.Dept./2016,Dated 18.03.2017 that was placed in the AHCT portal regarding treatment of Aarogyasri & EHS Beneficiaries of Telangana State in Andhra Pradesh Network Hospitals of AHCT.

In this connection as per discussions on de-empanelment of hospitals outside the geographic jurisdiction of Telangana, held in 19th Trust Board meeting: the following actions are proposed.

1. All Network Hospitals of Andhra Pradesh State (both Govt. and private) which are empanelled under Aarogyasri Health Care Trust, Telangana are to be de-empanelled from 18.9.2017.
2. The circular mentioned above dated 18.03.2017 and any other circulars prior to date on the matter of empanelment of hospitals in Andhra Pradesh under Aarogyasri Health Care Trust, Telangana stands to be cancelled.


As per the procedures in vogue the post de-empanelment clauses as mentioned below holds good and are to be Scrupulously implemented by the concerned establishments.

In this connection Clauses (I) (II) and (III) of the SCC of Service Contract Agreement stipulates as follows:

“(i) Procedure after Delisting/de-empanelment of hospital/Suspension/withdrawal of Services/withdrawing from the scheme(s), by the hospital.

- I. In case of above the login and user id of Network Hospital cannot be used for registering of new patients. However the NWH can login for processing “On-bed cases and follow-up cases” .Treating new patients under Aarogyasri scheme shall not be allowed.
- II. The On-bed patients who are already admitted under Aarogyasri and undergoing treatment in NWH have to be provided 100% cashless facility till they are discharged by the hospital.
- III. All cases which are registered or admitted and for which preauthorization is already given shall be treated under the scheme as per preauthed amount.

Hence all the Network hospitals of Andhra Pradesh state (both Govt and Private) which are empanelled under Aarogyasri Health Care Trust are requested to follow the above instructions.
